



# JUST FOR YOU!

Over two thousand years ago, there was great joy in Heaven as the angels rejoiced and worshipped before the throne of God because of His big love-project that was perfectly accomplished on earth – the redemption and justification of man through His Son Jesus Christ. That great joy continues to resound whenever anyone receives God's great offer of salvation. Have you received God's great offer of Salvation? This is therefore what being born again is all about. It is more than a religious terminology – it's about receiving God's gift of salvation.

After the fall of the first man, Adam, which introduced the whole human race to sin and death, God had a plan to restore man to His eternal purpose. To accomplish this He sent His Son Jesus Christ into the world to become man's eternal and perfect substitute because man was so helpless, being under the dominance of his new master – the devil. Jesus said, *“For God so greatly loved and dearly prized the world that He [even] gave up His only begotten (unique) son, so that whoever believes in (trusts in, clings to, relies on) Him shall not perish (come to destruction, be lost) but have eternal (everlasting) life.”* (John 3:16, AMP). Defining His purpose for coming to the earth, Jesus said *“...I came that they may have and enjoy life, and have it in abundance (to the full, till it overflows)”*. (John 10:10, AMP).

However, to carry out this mission as man's substitute, Jesus Christ had to come to the earth, live as a man, suffer and die to bear the penalty for man's sin. The Scripture shows us that God vented His anger against sin and its effects on Jesus Christ for our sakes. Isaiah 53:4 tells us: *“Surely he hath borne our griefs, and carried our sorrows: yet we did esteem him stricken, smitten of God, and afflicted.”* This was what every man was supposed to bear for his own sin. Jesus didn't suffer for His own sin, for He was without a single sin – He was perfect! He took on Himself all our sins and infirmities and nailed them to the cross through His death. On the third day Jesus rose to life as a sign of His victory over satan, sin and death for man. Today, anyone [whosoever, no matter what he has done] who believes in and receives Jesus Christ as Lord and Saviour will be free from God's wrath. But those who reject Him will have to suffer eternal death with the devil for their own sins. This Salvation is not automatic. John 3:16 shows us that it's only for those who would believe in and receive Jesus Christ.

All that Jesus did was not for Himself but for us. He had no sin – no troubles. It was man who was in trouble because of sin. It was a substitutionary work that Jesus did. He took our place that we might take His place. In the mind of Justice, by virtue of our identification with Jesus; we suffered with Him, died with Him, were buried with Him, conquered with Him, resurrected with Him and are now seated with Him in Heavenly places far above principalities and powers (Eph.1:21;2:6)! While Jesus was on that cross He bore the sins of the whole human race on Himself. However, when we become born again we are New Creations in Christ and sons of God. The devil is forever defeated; he has lost his dominion over everyone who is born again! The new creation is God imparting His life, being, nature and substance into a mere man! That man suddenly becomes super-human, superior to sin, sickness and satan.

Jesus didn't have to go through all those painful experiences. He was in good fellowship with the Father God. But He did that just for you, He didn't suffer in vain. You're worth His blood – that's your true value. You can only receive these benefits when He becomes your Saviour and Lord. If you have not accepted God's gift of salvation, I invite you to pray these words right where you are and mean it:

**Dear God, thank you for giving your Son Jesus Christ to die for my sins, making it possible for me to possess eternal life instead of eternal death. I confess Jesus Christ as my Lord and Saviour and I believe in my heart that you raised Him from the dead for my justification. In accordance with your Word, I declare that I am saved, I am born again, I now have eternal life. I ask that you also fill me with your Holy Spirit and help me connect with your eternal purpose for my life. Thank you Father, in Jesus' Name. Amen.**

Congratulations! Welcome to God's family. You are now born again. It is important that you get a copy of the Bible, read it and pray everyday to your Heavenly Father and attend a Bible-based Church.
